Use “Career and Professional Growth Self-Assessment” to explore your professional potential. The tool is designed to facilitate a reflective examination of your career goals, obstacles, and achievements. The tool helps pinpoint areas for development, sharpen your objectives, and create plans for enhancing your workplace satisfaction and achievement.

### How to Perform the Self-Assessment

- Step 1: For each interaction, score from 1 to 10 how often the challenge occurs.
- Step 2: Score from 1 to 10 the level of stress the challenge causes you.
- Step 3: Multiply scores from Steps 1 and 2 to calculate the growth opportunity score.
- Note: *1 is the lowest occurrence, with 10 being the highest occurrence on the scale.*
- There are no wrong answers, use the assessment to identify strengths and opportunities for growth

## Enhancing Career Pathways: Actions for Growth Opportunities

For each Career and Professional Growth opportunity with a low score, here are suggested improvement actions:

- **Goal Setting:** Setting unrealistic or unclear career goals
  - Improvement Action: Refine your goals by making them SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound). Break larger goals into smaller, manageable steps and regularly review and adjust them as needed.
- **Skill Development:** Failing to keep up with industry changes or new technologies
  - Improvement Action: Dedicate time each week to learning and development activities, such as online courses, webinars, or reading industry-related materials. Identify key trends and technologies impacting your field and seek resources to upskill accordingly.
- **Networking:** Not engaging in professional networking opportunities
  - Improvement Action: Actively seek out networking opportunities, both online and in person. Join professional associations, attend industry conferences, and participate in webinars and workshops. Make a habit of reaching out to new contacts regularly and maintaining your existing network.
- **Seeking Feedback:** Resistance to receiving or acting on constructive criticism
